



Texas Junior Clays Program

(Supporting Bob Brister Memorial Scholarship)

Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and Texas Sporting Clays Association announce an exciting new program for entry level shooters. This program is targeting youth participants who are not currently engaged in shooting sporting clays. The program is designed as an entry level activity to introduce the game of sporting clays so more shooters may develop an interest and possibly participate in hunting ventures.

Program Description

- 1) Participants must have no more than 500 lifetime registered NSCA targets, and will participate in the "Hunter Class Division."
- 2) All NSCA clubs participating in this program will run a "Hunter Class Division" shoot in conjunction with a registered NSCA event.
- 3) Participants will shoot 100 targets in "Hunter Class."
- 4) There will be three age divisions: Sub-Junior, Age 9-12; Junior, Age 13-15; and Senior, Age 16-18. Note: All NSCA Rules will be applicable with the exception of age class division. Class age will be determined as of age on January 1 of each year.
- 5) All participating ranges have agreed to pay for at least one entrant into the main even of the State Sporting Clays Shoot. Note: The winner from each age division will be placed in a drawing to determine whose entry will be paid.
- 6) Should any club wish to pay for the winner of all three age divisions, they may do so.
- 7) A \$1000 scholarship and a paid entry into the main concurrent event at the National Sporting Clays Championship will be available for each division winner and will be awarded at the State Sporting Clay Shoot.
- 8) TSCA has interested individuals willing to sponsor unpaid winners from each event.
- 9) TSCA will pay for one additional participant to attend the National Sporting Clays Championship from all entrants to be determined by drawing.
